

**PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMITTEE MEETING
MINUTES
June 23, 2010**

The meeting of the Public Utilities Committee was called to order by Chairman Keith Endy. Committee members present in addition to Mr. Endy, were Gene Gabel, Barry Christman, and ex-officio member Frank Deery.

Also in attendance were Council members Lori Carnes and Terry Mest; Borough Manager, Patricia Spaide, Dennis Harman, The Pidcock Company, Marc DesAutels and Nathan Lauck, Severn Trent Environmental Services, and a concerned citizen.

A motion to approve the minutes of the May 26, 2010 meeting of the committee was made by Mr. Endy, seconded by Mr. Christman, and approved.

Severn Trent Environmental Services Report – Water and Sewer

Mr. DesAutels and Mr. Lauck reviewed with the members the Severn Trent report on the operation of the Water and Wastewater Plants and distribution systems.

The Pidcock Company Engineers' Report

Mr. Harman reviewed the Engineers' Report for the month of June. The complete report is on file in the Borough Administrative office.

Approximately 15,334,000 gallons were pumped from the Trout Run Reservoir. There was no pumping from Ironstone Creek during the month. The level of Popodickon Dam increased approximately 9 inches since last month's report.

Regarding the Booster Pumping System, Mr. Harman noted that the pumps and flow-rate control valves are operating satisfactorily. A few punch list items are being completed.
