Once again we would like to say thank you to all the residents and all the volunteers of the many committees who make this town a special place to live in. We truly do have a neat little town and all of our efforts make it what it is.

We would like to take this opportunity to let you know some of the decisions Council and the various committees have made over the past year.

Our Park and Recreation Board had a successful 2010 Sensational Summer. Events at the park this year included Earth Day, Fun Days, Movies Under the Stars and our Fall Festival. All the events were well attended and enjoyed by all. Council also approved a \$5,000.00 donation to the Boyertown YMCA Splash Pad Project at the Community Pool, and a \$30,000 donation to the Boyertown Rotary Club toward the Playground for Everyone Project at the Community Park. The funds for the donation to the Rotary Club Project came from the Kumpf Estate Bequest. The bequest was designated for playground improvements at the Community Park.

Our street department was very busy thru-out the year. Remember all the snow last winter. The department spent many hours plowing and salting the roads. During the spring and summer many hours were spent mowing grass at the parks and keeping town clean. Of course this fall, remember all the leaves. Many hours are spent removing them.

Council approved the Jefferson Street repaving project from Philadelphia Avenue to Third Street. That project was completed in August.

Council also approved the purchase of a 2010 Ford Explorer for the police department, and a 2011 GMC pick-up truck equipped with a snow plow and salt spreader for the street department. Also approved was Contract Year #17 budget with Severn Trent Environmental Services, the contract operator of the water and sewer plants and distribution systems.
