## Police and Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes November 29, 2023

## **Unfinished Business**

**Pedestrian Crosswalk Signs** – The required Sketch Plan and Letter of Request to install pedestrian crosswalk signs at the following unsignalized intersections; West Philadelphia Avenue and Walnut Street; East Philadelphia Avenue and Franklin Street; North Reading Avenue and 5<sup>th</sup> Street; and South Reading Avenue and Third Street, was submitted to PennDOT on October 23<sup>rd</sup>. Nothing new to report.

**Intersection of Seventh Street and North Reading Avenue** – No response from Penn Dot at this time.

**Salvation Army Food Pantry Distribution** – Mayor Carnes advised that she has met with Salvation Army personnel regarding the committee's concern about traffic congestion on Walker Drive during the Salvation Army's weekly food pantry distribution. No specific resolution has been determined at this time.

## **New Business**

**Resolution Hazard Mitigation Plan Update** – Mrs. Loder reviewed with the committee a resolution to adopt an updated Hazard Mitigation Plan. The update of the plan was initiated by the Berks County Commissioners on behalf of all the municipalities in the County. Each municipality must now adopt the plan, which in doing so will allow the municipality to be eligible for disaster mitigation grant funds. Adoption of the resolution will be listed on the agenda of the December 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of Council.
